

# State Group Urges Survey of Freeway

Recommendation that the State set up projects for the purpose of survey, design and advance rights of way acquisition for a San Gabriel River freeway has been made by the California Chamber of Commerce.

The proposed San Gabriel Freeway would connect the San Bernardino Freeway with the San Diego Freeway.

Under projects for long-term planning, the Chamber proposes a Colorado-Foothill Freeway to become part of an interstate highway system.

The California Highway Commission will consider the recommendations in its study of the 1957-58 State highway budget.

# Three-Acre Park Planned in El Monte

EL MONTE—A three-acre sports park, complete with community clubhouse, casting pool and archery range, is in store for El Monte residents soon.

The city of El Monte is planning to buy the land for \$10,000 in order to set up recreational facilities not usually found in parks in crowded areas.

The Izaak Walton League will establish the park near Valley Blvd. and Hoyt St. Another \$10,000 has been included in the proposed city budget to improve the area bordering the Rio Hondo Flood Control Channel.
