

INCORPORATION OF ROSSMOOR BEATEN

Cityhood Proposal for Orange County Community Defeated by 1,656 to 1,151

ROSSMOOR, Aug. 2—Voters in this community today turned down incorporation as Orange County's 23rd city by a vote of 1,656 no to 1,151 yes.

County officials said there are 100 absentee votes still to be counted, but they will not affect the outcome of the election.

There were 14 candidates for five seats on the city council of the proposed city, but results of that balloting *will have no effect now that the incorporation move has failed.*

2,816 Voted

A total of 2,816 voters went to the polls out of a registration of 3,999.

The proposed new city would have taken in an estimated 7,000 acres from the southern boundary of the city of Los Alamitos southward into the Seal Beach Naval Ammunition and Net Depot and west of the San Gabriel River.

It would have had a population of approximately 10,000.
